We are here to help you along your homeschool journey! Use this shopping checklist to help you easily select courses for your family.

Language Arts Our full-year language arts courses for preschool through high school thoroughly cover everything needed for teaching these language arts subjects: phonics, reading, literature, writing, spelling, vocabulary, grammar, usage, punctuation, poetry, geography, and art history and appreciation. The full course set should be purchased and includes all components needed to complete each course. It is recommended that students complete 4 lessons per week.

These courses are slightly advanced compared to public school grade levels. In general, children can begin on grade level unless extra reading help is needed. If you are unsure of which level to select, give your child our *Language Arts Placement Test* found at goodandbeautiful.com/placement.

Brand-new editions of Levels 4–7 released in 2026. All four levels use the brand-new *Simply Spelling* online program. This customized spelling program is free and is geared toward grades 4–8. It can be used with our language arts courses or as a stand-alone spelling program. Optional physical *Simply Spelling* practice books are available for purchase. Take the *Spelling Placement Test* found at goodandbeautiful.com/placement.

The *Quick Reference Guide* is a brand-new resource for Levels 4–8. Purchase once and use it throughout these levels as a grammar, usage, diagramming, and vocabulary reference tool.

Math Math Simply Good and Beautiful Math courses closely match public school grade levels. Our math uses a spiral teaching method, so previously learned concepts are frequently reviewed. The full course set should be purchased and includes all components needed to complete each course. It is recommended to complete 4 lessons per week.

In most cases, the child's course level matches their grade level. Administer our Math Placement Test found at goodandbeautiful.com/placement if you are unsure of where to begin with your child.

Math K–3 course sets each come with a course book and math box with course-specific manipulatives.

All Math 4–8 course sets include course books, an answer key or solutions manual, and digital access to video lessons. Additionally, Math 5 includes *Extra Practice Worksheets* PDFs. Optional *Extra Practice Worksheets* PDFs are available for purchase for Math 7 and 8 for additional review.

Handwriting Courses range from preschool to Level 7. Cursive instruction begins in Level 3. When in doubt, start on a lower level. It is recommended to complete 3–4 sheets per week to complete a workbook in one year.

Science Our family-style science units can be taught in any order. Each unit includes 8–15 lessons. We recommend that families select 2–3 units per school year and complete 2 lessons a week.

Younger children in preschool through second grade are introduced to the wonders of science with our *Science for Little Hearts and Hands* units. We recommend completing one course per year at a rate of one lesson per week. Optionally, young children can participate in our family-style science units for grades 3–8 by using the corresponding *Science Activity Books*.

High School Biology is for students in grades 9–12. Students complete the course as an independent study. The course set includes six physical *Unit Workbooks*, online *Wonders of Biology* texts, access to digital video lessons and labs, the *Tests & Quizzes Booklet*, and the PDF *Answer Key*.

History Our full-color history courses for grades 3–8 are taught family-style. Components for each full-year course include a Family Set, which consists of a *History Course Book*, *Maps & Images Book*, and *Big Book of History Stories*. The following items need to be purchased individually: *Time Tunnel Review Cards*, *Time Line Book*, and a *Grades 3–6 Student Explorer* or *Grades 7–8 Student Explorer*. An optional *History Activity Book* is available for children in grades K–2. *History Year 4* is expected to release in February 2027.

Our one-semester *US Constitution and Government* course for grades 4–8 can be completed independently from any of our other history courses. It is recommended that students complete 2 lessons per week.

Electives The Good and the Beautiful Electives program is designed to open up a world of wonder and exploration for all children. Each course averages 10–20 lessons and gives children a fun way to learn new skills. A handful of offerings are available now, but dozens more are in the works!

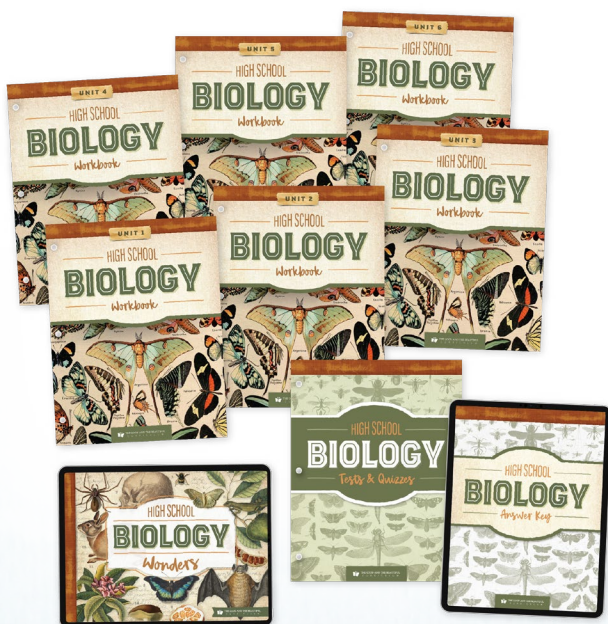

Purchase one Family Set per household.

Each student in grades 3-8 will need their own age-appropriate consumable student explorer. The consumable history activity book is an optional way to include younger learners.

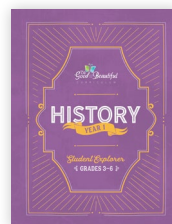
