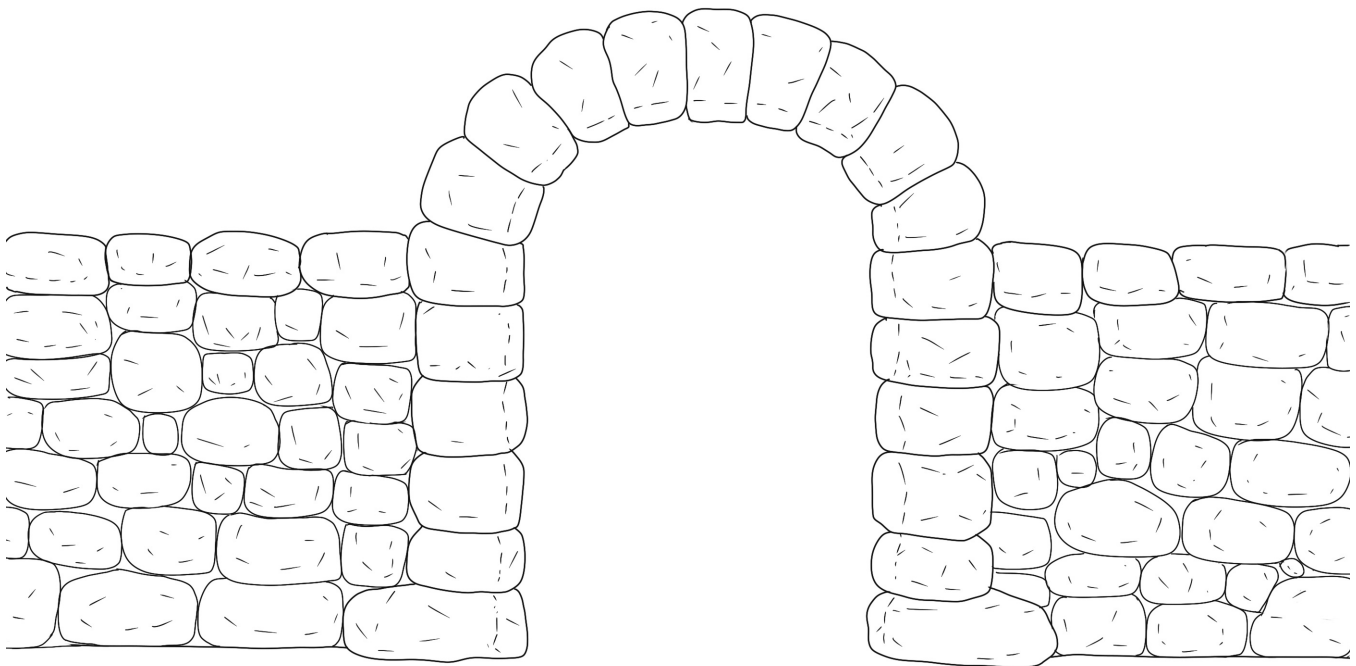


Evaluation #1—Results Practice
