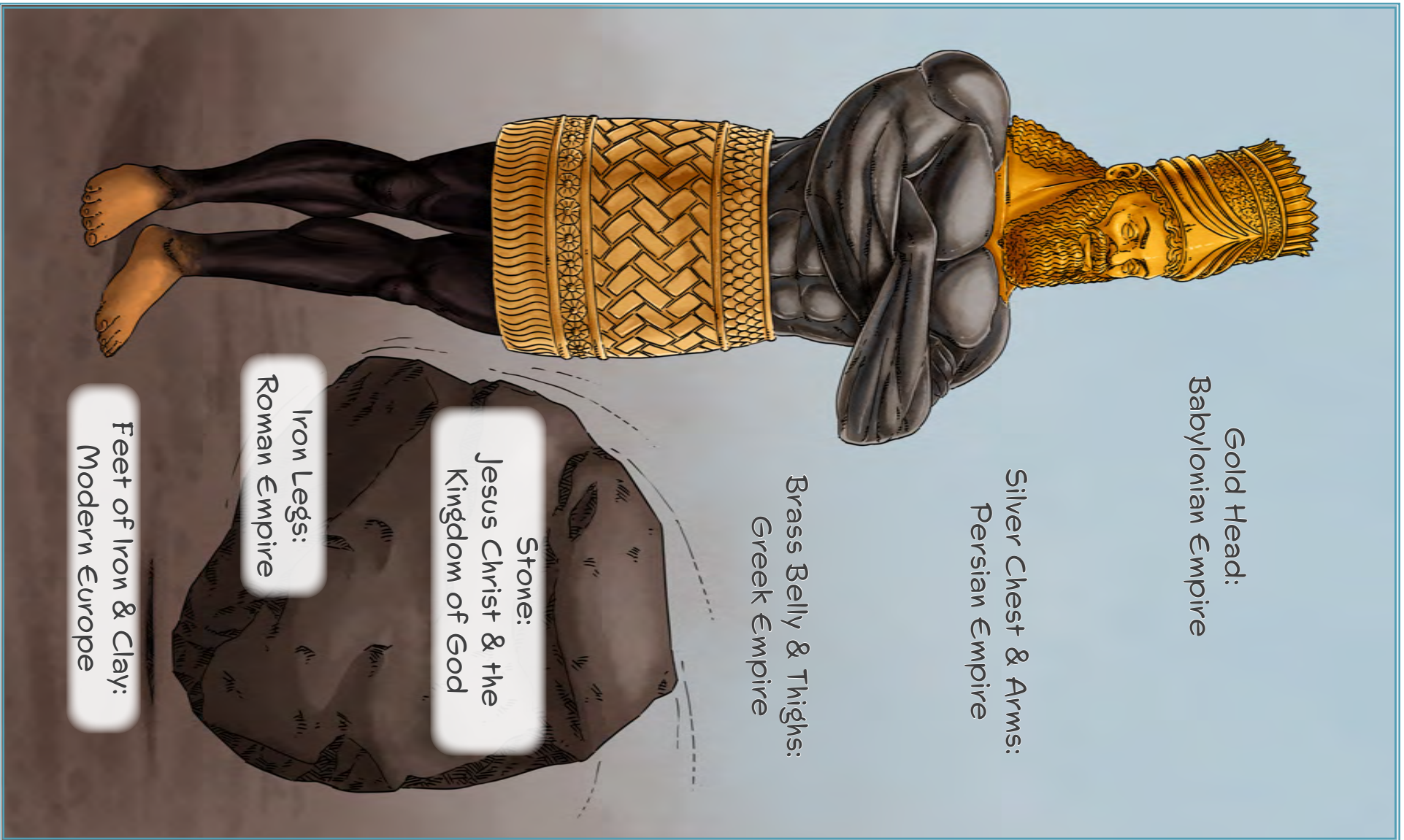

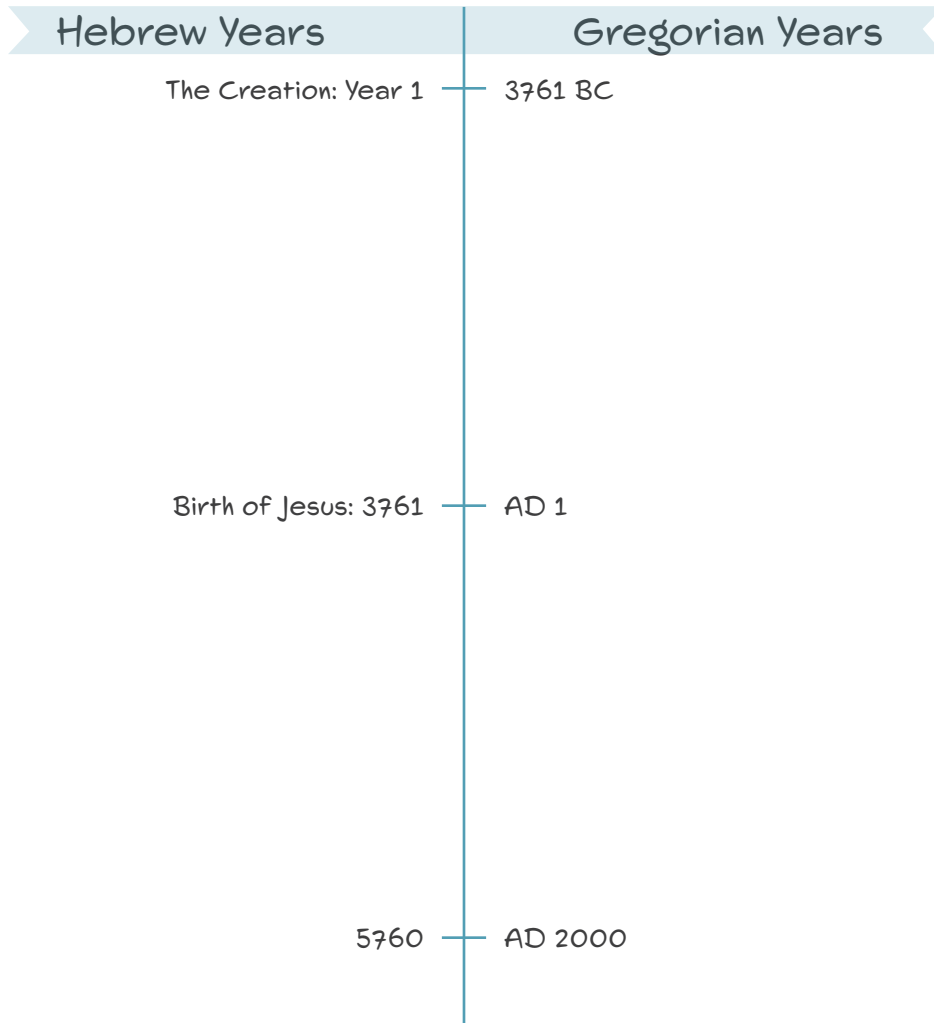

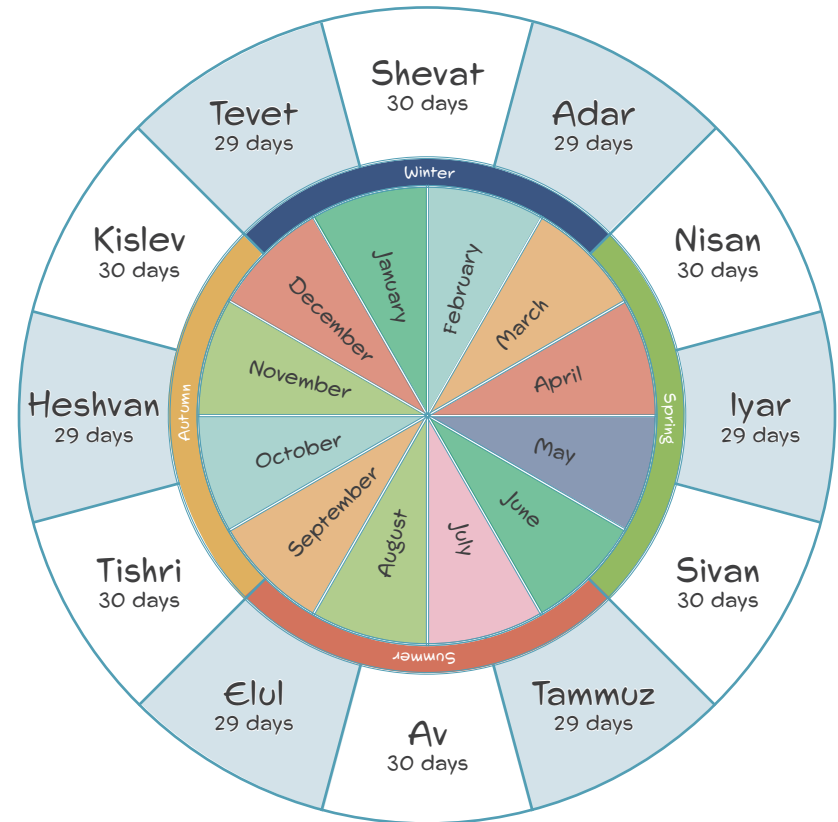
HEBREW CALENDAR

Time Line



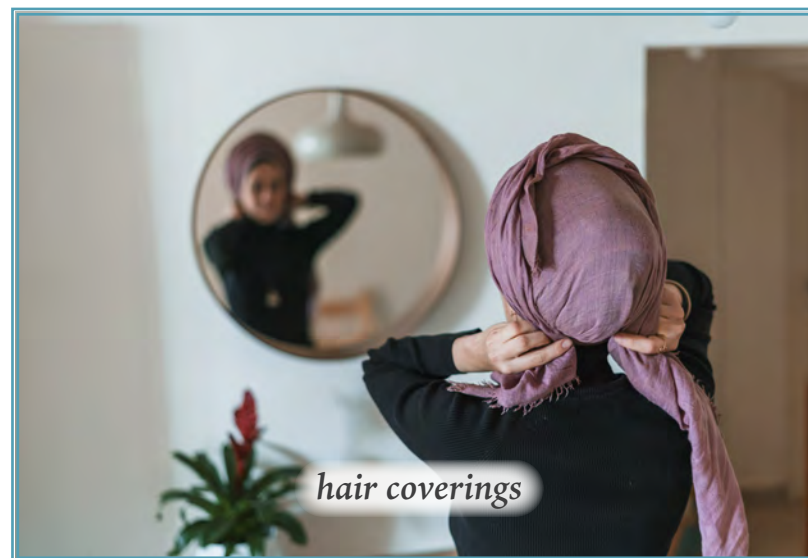
The Hebrew time line begins at year 1 with the Creation.

There are 12 Hebrew months, three to each season of the year. Each month has either 29 or 30 days.

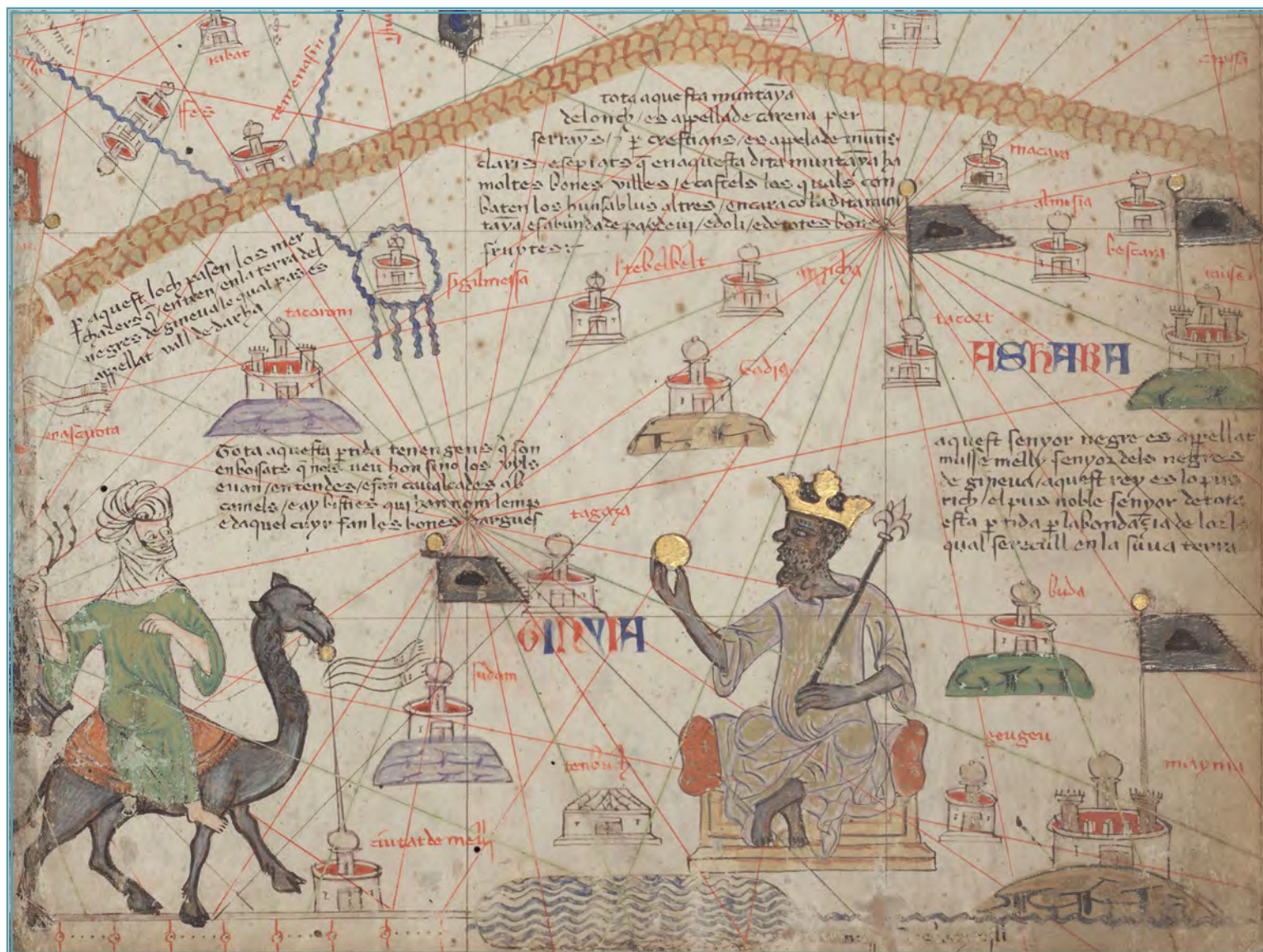

HAUDENOSAUNEE & US GOVERNMENTS

Haudenosaunee Confederacy	United States Constitution
Members cannot hold more than one office in the Confederacy.	Members of Congress cannot hold other federal government offices, and members of the executive and judicial branches cannot serve in Congress.
There is a process to remove leaders if needed.	There is a process to remove the president, vice president, or civil officers from office if needed.
There are two branches of legislature and a process for passing laws.	There are two branches of Congress, the House of Representatives and the Senate, each with specific powers.
The 50 chiefs represent each nation and have the power to declare war.	Congress has the power to declare war.
Power is balanced between the Haudenosaunee Confederacy and the individual nations.	Power is divided between the federal government and the individual states.

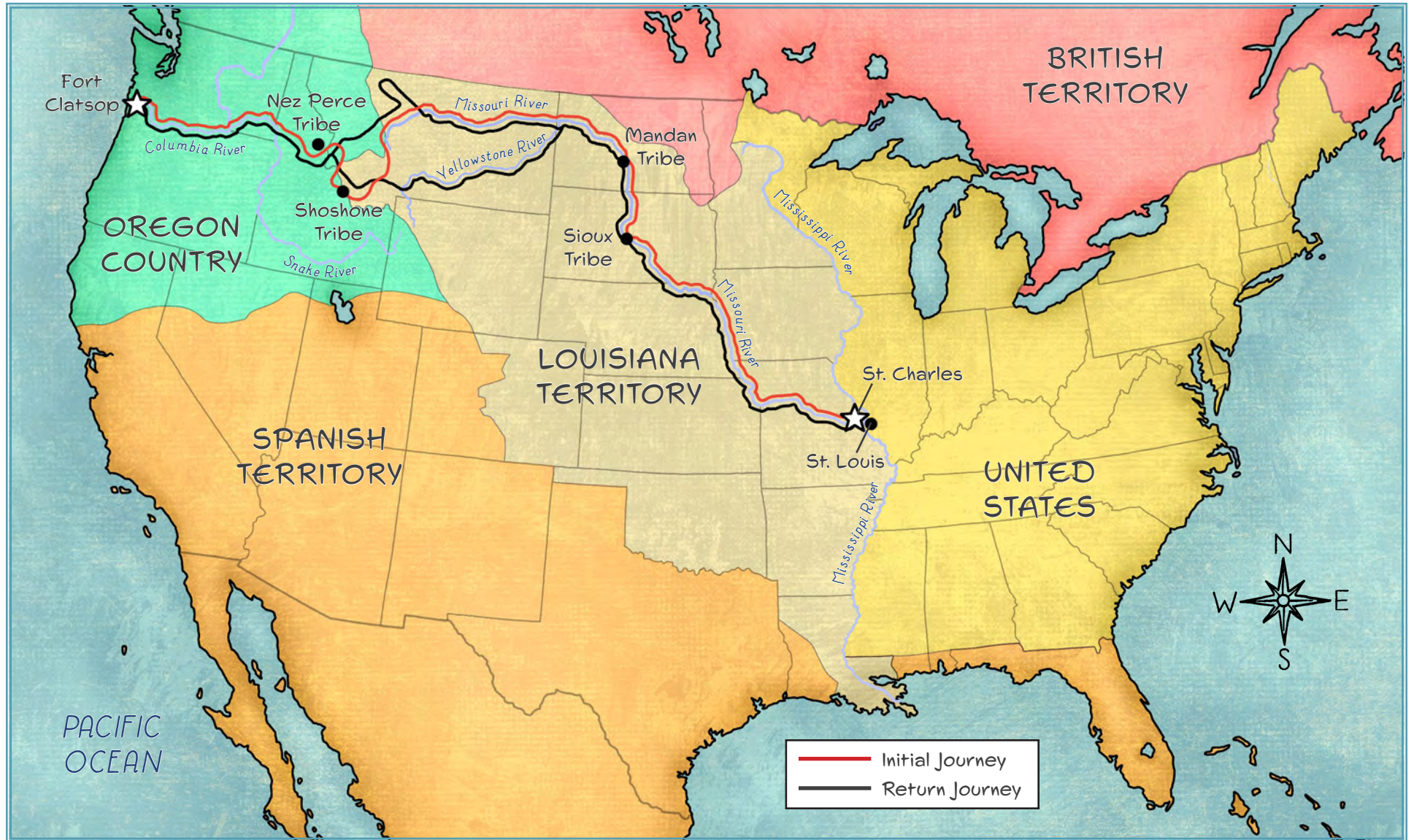

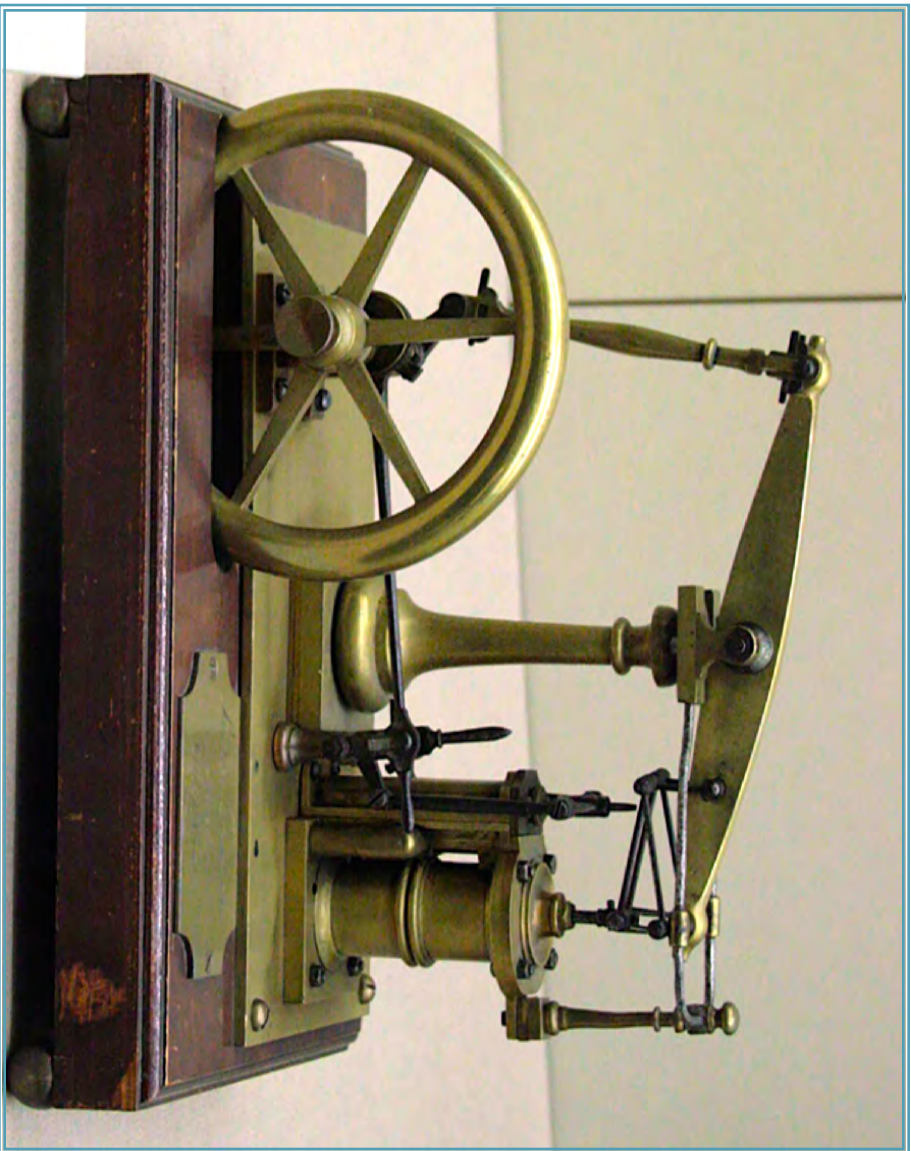

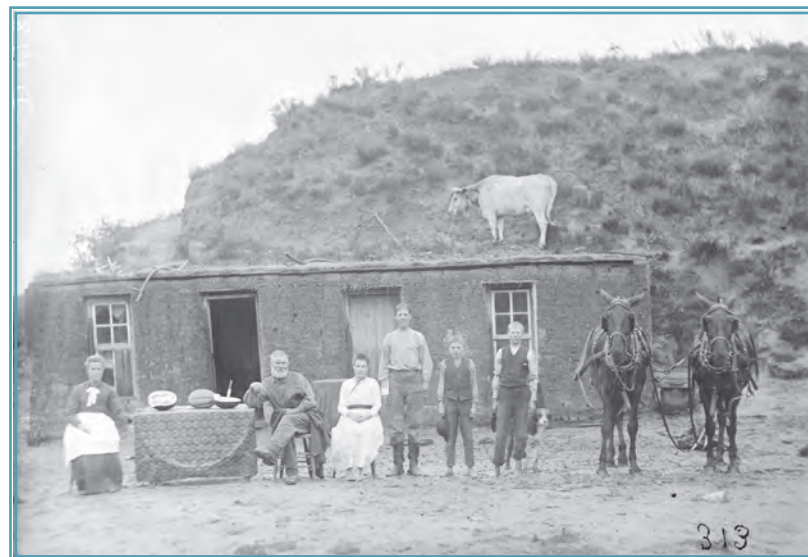

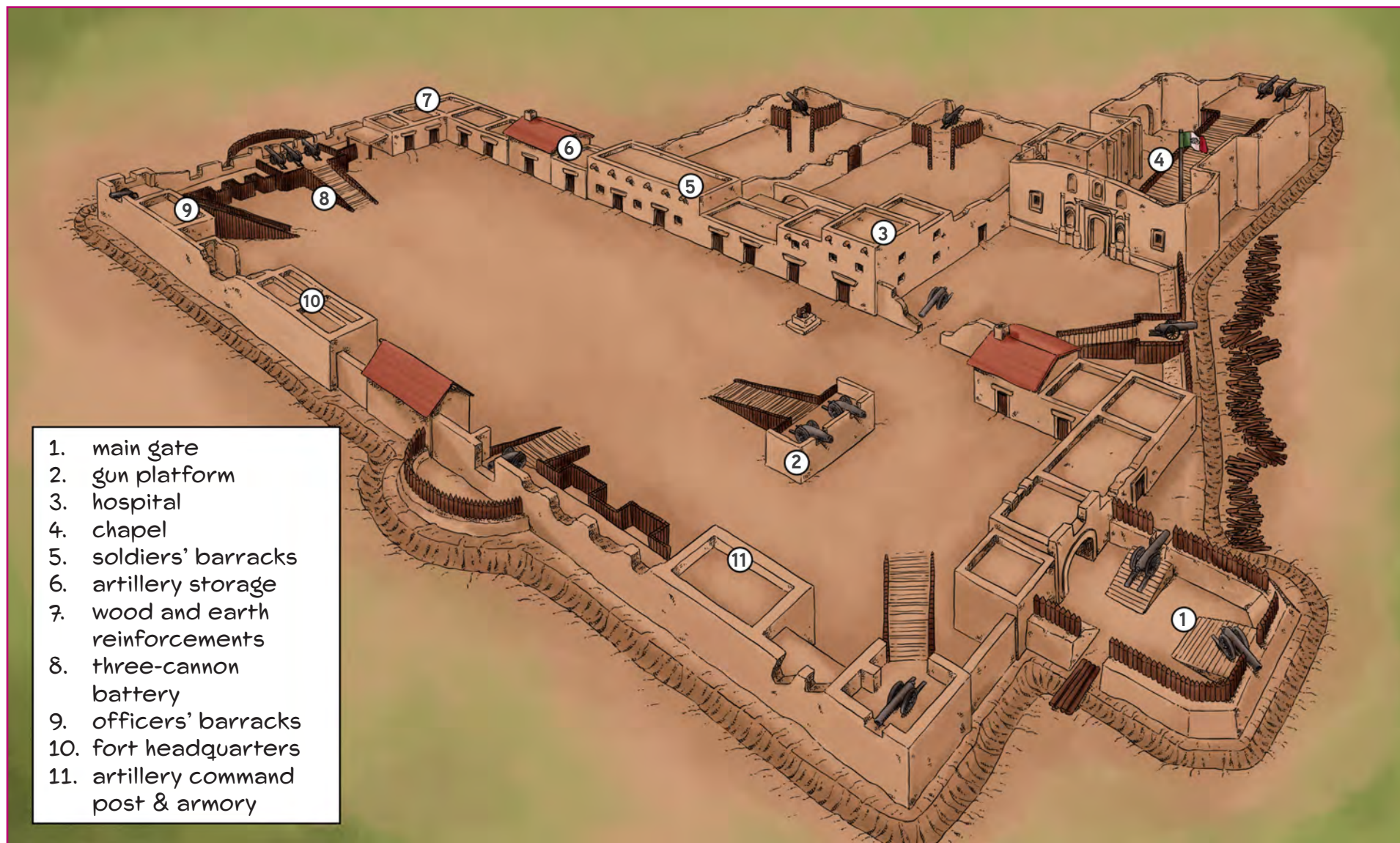

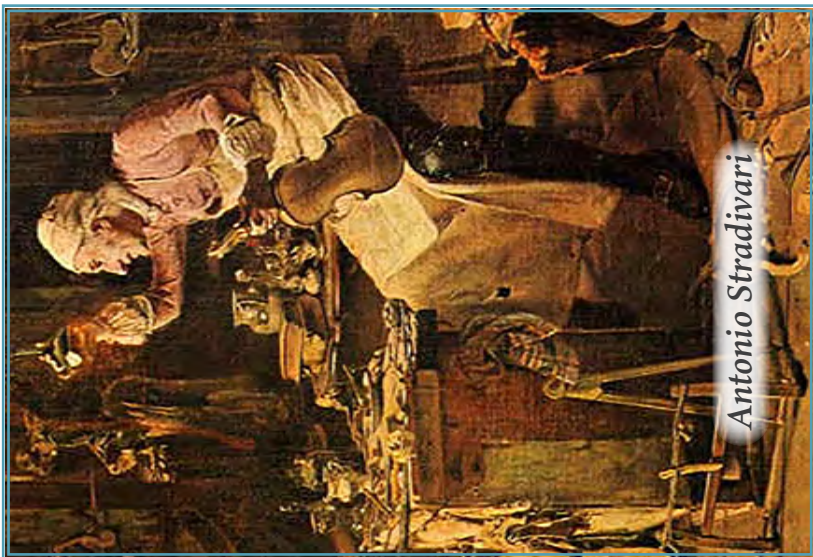
