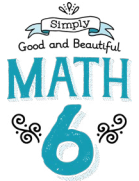
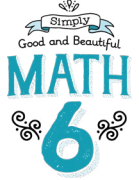
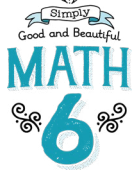


High School Math Tracks
